Is your child looking to do something different and exciting this summer? Are you looking for something they can do that is fun while exploring their inner creativity? Let us bring some color into their lives! With the help of music and visual effects developed specifically for elementary school children, your child will learn about the arts in a structured yet fun-filled environment. Each week we will complete a new Arts & Crafts project that will teach your child everything from basic color theory to a little Art History.

### The 6 classes will include:

#### **Monday, July 13** What kind of an Artist are you?

This will be an introductory class where we will teach a little art history. The children will then design their very own smocks with their favorite type of artist's technique (e.g. Monét, Dali, etc.). They will use these smocks throughout all the classes and will take them home at the end of the 6 sessions.

#### **Monday, July 20** Let's Explore the World of Color!

On this day, not only will the children be artists, they will also be Artistic Chef's! The class will be learning all about Primary vs. Secondary Colors and then make their very own edible Color Wheels!

#### **Monday, July 27** Color Theory: A la Andy Warhol

In this class, we will have a brief discussion about the artist Andy Warhol. We will then talk about some of the earth's Endangered Species. The children will be asked to pick an animal and then experiment with Primary and Secondary colors as Warhol did to make designs of their own. This class will bring awareness not only to the art of Warhol but to the responsibilities we all have to the earth we all share.



#### **Monday, August 3** "Stained Glass" Landscapes

This class is designed to work with a child's small motor skills. They will start by drawing a landscape they like and then learn how to turn it into "stained glass" by working with construction paper and colored tissue paper. By cutting and pasting the pieces that make up their landscape, they will leave with a beautiful "window" accent that they can hang in their own home.

#### **Monday, August 10** The Creature of Paper Maché

How about REALLY getting your child's imagination working! This class will have the students bring in a 3 to 4 inch rock of an unusual shape from outdoors. They will then have to look at the rock and decided what kind of animal it could be according to it's shape. We will leave these "Creatures" to dry until the next class. During this class, we will take a portrait photograph of each child to be printed off for the next class's assignment.

#### **Monday, August 17** Reflections and Piggy Banks!

In the last class we will be working on a few things. The children will each get their portrait photo back except it will be printed with only half of their face! The pencil drawing exercise will be for each child to complete the other half (or reflection) of their own face. We will teach the children about gray values and the importance of duplicating what they see from one side to the other.

We will finish by having each child paint their "Creature" from the week before and also having them paint a design on their own ceramic piggy bank. They will go home with both "Animals"... one for a paper weight and the other for learning the importance of savings.
