#### **SUPPLY LIST FOR BEGINNERS:**

##### **PASTELS**

###### **Hard Pastels:**

###### **Prismacolor NuPastels**

(Minimum of 36 set, available in sets of 48, 72 and 96, the more the merrier.)

###### **Portable Field Drawing Board**

###### **Portfolio to transport your work**

###### **Glassine Sheets** (this protects the paintings in transport)

*The above items are available at Jerry's Artarama, Dick Blick or ASW online less expensive than in retail stores.*

###### **Soft Pastels:** (Base on budget, personal experience and availability)

A set of assorted pastels including a small set (or individual sticks) of dark, soft pastels. There are many good brands available in art stores (i.e. / AI Freidman etc) and more brands are available through catalogues i.e. / Jerry's Artarama; Dick Blick, and Art Supply Warehouse. Pastel brands include Rembrandt, Windsor Newton, Sennelier and Art Spectrum. Individual selected colors are available and recommended.

**Note:** Optional pastels are Holbein Soft Pastels, which are good for blending.

*Make sure you have plenty of Dark Pastels. Some great sets are....*

*Terry Ludwig's Dark Set II, Girault's Dark Set, Dianne Townsend's 12 Darks or Unison's Dark Set work well.*

##### **PAPER**

I will have Magenta Toned Wallis Sheets available for \$10/sheet and various size Black Gator that will have my rough surface pre-made available from \$5 small, \$10 medium and \$15 for large. These are random sized boards.

##### **Fan Brush or other soft brush to erase errors, Small tarpaulin or Large Beach Towel to catch dust on floor, Masking tape, Scissors**

*The following items are not necessary but keep your hands from drying out and make it easier to clean them afterwards.*

Latex or Vinyl Powdered Gloves (you can get at any pharmacy), Liquid Glove (Jerry's or online), Kerodex 151 (Used by Mechanics and people who work with machinery, order through a pharmacy.)
