SUPPLY LIST:

Sketch Book (*Any size that's comfortable to carry easily anywhere. As a student, I used to carry around a 5.5 x 8.5" sketchbook.*)

Sketch Pad (*Any white sketch pad at least 11x14". I recommend Canson Classic White Drawing Pads. The sheets are perforated so as to easily remove sheets.*)

Canson Mi-Teintes Paper (*These come in individual sheets. Color: 1 Felt Gray & 1 Hemp*)

Note: *An individual sheet of Canson paper is 19.75 x 25.5" and can be cut into quarters. Please store flat and don't wrinkle paper.*

Conté Sketching or Drawing Pencils (*White, Black & Sepia*)

A Set of 12 Colored Pencils (*Raffiné Colored Pencil Sets are the least expensive that I have found online at Jerry's Artarama for \$4.99 a set*)

Pencil Sharpener

Kneaded Eraser

Something to carry supplies in (*can be a large bag, knapsack, Art-Bin, etc.*)

The above items are available at Jerry's Artarama in Elmwood (West Hartford), Dick Blick in Plainville or Michael's in Meriden. The first two are very much cheaper than Michael's if you can make the trip. You can also order online at www.jerrysartarama.com, www.dickblick.com, or www.aswexpress.com to save even more money on supplies. P.S: Jerry's in Elmwood does not have the same pricing as online Jerry's, so be aware of that.

Smock (*This can be as simple as a man's shirt.*)
